2022-2023 SUPPLY LIST – KINDERGARTEN**

Please bring the following supplies with you on the first day of school:

1. 2 Large boxes of tissues
2. 4 large glue sticks.
3. 2 Zipper Pencil Pouches (No boxes) – large size – clear plastic rip easily.
4. One pocket folder for papers and one blue folder **with prongs.**
5. Large Backpack or Book Bag to carry home papers and all belongings.
6. 2 packs of crayons (replace as needed)
7. 1 pack colored Crayola pencils
8. 1 pack fat size markers
9. 2 wide ruled notebooks
10. 2 plain rectangular erasers (no toy or character types)
11. #2 lead pencils (**already sharpened**) Bring entire pack to school **NO MECHANICAL PENCILS**
12. Scissors (Fiskars)
13. 2 rolls of paper towels. (Large Rolls)
14. 1 box of gallon 1 box of sandwich Ziploc Baggies.
15. 2 Black dry erase markers (low odor). Fat Size.
16. Over the ear headphones to plug into iPads
17. 1 large container of baby wipes and 2 Clorox Wipes
18. 1 one inch 3 ring binder.
19. White paper bags (boys) Brown paper bags (girls)
20. 4 Large playdough containers (replace throughout the year)
21. Gym Clothes: **Plain red or black shorts or sweatpants**, plain navy, gray, white or red tee shirt, tennis shoes. You may buy these at any store but we will offer a chance to buy uniforms with the St. Rose “Cougar” Emblem at the beginning of school. The Home and School Association will send home the order form. Gym clothes may be worn to school on Tuesday (gym day). They will not need gym clothes for the first week of school, but after that please have your child wear gym clothes to school every Tuesday.
22. Please send a DAILY HEALTHY SNACK (dry cereal, fruit rollup, fruit(sliced, peeled), pretzels, yogurt(spoon) cereal bars, Jell-O, cheese, crackers. **NO COOKIES OR CHIPS.**

**Please remember that some of their supplies (glue, glue sticks, crayons, pencils, etc.) will need to be replaced several times during the school year. When the prices on these items are down in the summer, you may want to buy extra for replacing during the winter months.
