

2025-26 Tuition and Fees

<u>Tuition Rate</u> K-8= \$6,165 per student

Payment in full must be made or a payment plan on the tuition agreement must be submitted by August 1, 2025. Those selecting a payment plan will incur a \$150 per family finance fee.

Registration Fees

No student will be considered registered for the 2025-26 school year until this non-refundable fee is paid. This fee is not covered under any tuition assistance programs.

New Student Registration Fee (K-8)= \$50/student Returning Student Registration Fee= \$50/family

Instructional Fee

All students are assessed an instructional fee. This non-refundable fee is due by August 1st. No student will be scheduled for classes until this fee is paid. This fee is NOT COVERED under any tuition assistance programs, including EdChoice.

Instructional Fee (K-8)= \$100 per student

2025-26 Financial Aid Information

• EdChoice Scholarship

All students in the state of Ohio are eligible for an EdChoice Scholarship. Traditional scholarships for 2025–26 are for eligible students living in Youngstown, Warren, and Campbell school districts, as well as those assigned to W.S. Guy MS in Liberty. Expansion scholarships are available for ALL other students, ranging from \$616.60 to \$6,166. The award amount is on a sliding scale that is income-based. For families whose total household income is 450% of the federal poverty guidelines or less (i.e. family of 4= \$140,400), students will be eligible for a full scholarship that will cover the entire cost of tuition at St. Rose. Please see the EdChoice info packet for your specific EdChoice Scholarship award amount.

• Parishioner Scholarship

■ All students that are active parishioners at St. Rose or another Diocese of Youngstown parish are eligible to receive a scholarship, up to \$1,750 per student. Those who apply will be given a parish verification form for the Pastor to sign indicating that the family is active (time, talent, and treasure). Upon receiving a signed verification form, the scholarship will be awarded.

• Diocese of Youngstown and St. Rose Tuition Assistance Scholarships

- Several needs-based scholarships are available to students through application using FACTS Grants and Aid portal. Please see the instructions for logging into the portal to apply. The priority deadline to apply is March 1st, but applications will be accepted until funds are exhausted.
- Please note, ALL families that do not receive a full EdChoice scholarship are HIGHLY ENCOURAGED to apply for DOY and St. Rose scholarship assistance regardless of the total household income.
